

RTMM MedEvac Dispatch #E026B Equipment: Helicopter Amphibian Summer, Ski Plane or Tundra Winter

Special RTMM Scenery Requirements:

Tongass X

Starting Location: Bob Quinn Lake CBW4

Amphibian, Ski, Tundra: N56 58.3123 W130 15.0673 Heading: 059°

Helicopter: N56 58.3123 W130 15.0673

Location of Emergency: Bearing from Bob Quinn is 291° for 38 miles.

Medical Destination: Landing zone is ice in spring, fall, winter, Alternate nearby runway is at

way point M027X – Dirt Landing Zone.

Float Plane: Telegraph Creek Hospital M027B

Helicopter: Telegraph Creek Hospital Helipad: M027B

Nature of Emergency: Hunting Accident, gunshot wound. Victim in shock, semi-stable condition, needs immediate transport to Telegraph Creek Hospital. Victim has been transported to the Schaft Creek Airstrip for MedEvac. Landing zone is old airstrip (dirt).

Emergency Location: N57 21.2740 W131 0.9520 Topo Map

Emergency Way Point: E026B

- Helicopter: Set the GPS for way point for E026B. Use the starting position at Bob Quinn Lake at N56 58.5124 W130 15.0650. Fly to E026B and pick up the victim. Orange smoke has been deployed so you should hover to the pickup site. Transport victim to Telegraph Creek Hospital at way point M027B.
- Float Plane Set the GPS for way point for E026B. Use the starting position at Bob Quinn Lake at N56 58.5124 W130 15.0650 Heading: 050°. Fly to E026B and pick up the victim. Orange smoke has been deployed so you should taxi to the pickup site. Transport victim to Telegraph Creek Hospital at way point M027B. (If Winter, the landing zone is ice or you may land at the airport runway alternate nearby M027X)
