

## RTMM MedEvac Dispatch #E032B Equipment: Helicopter or Amphibian Snow Cat Accident – Near Frank Mackie Research Camp

## **Special RTMM Scenery Requirements:**

Summit Ice Station

Soule Glacier

Starting Location: Soule Landing

Amphibian: Position at: N55 48.7283 W130 8.5813 Heading 346.7°

Helicopter: Position at: N55 48.7382 W130 8.6075

**Location of Emergency:** Bearing from Soule Landing is 332° for 33 miles.

## **Medical Destination:**

Amphibian: Stewart Trauma Centre – Medical Dock

Helicopter: Stewart Trauma Centre - Helipad

**Nature of Emergency:** A snow cat turned over injuring the two people inside. One is severe and one is ambulatory but needs medical attention. They are in the proximity of the Frank Mackie Research Camp.

Emergency Location: N56 12.1697 W130 15.0658 Topo Map

**Emergency Way Point:** E032B

• **Instructions:** Set the GPS for way point for E032B. In bad weather, you can fly just above the Glaciers winding your way toward the Frank Mackie Research Camp. There is a hard ice runway and a helipad at the pickup point. Pick up the victims and transport them to Stewart Trauma Center M030 at way point M030B.
