

RTMM MedEvac Dispatch #E036B

Recommended Vehicle: Heli, Amphib, Ski Scenery Needed: Tongass X and RTMM SIRP NOTAM: Anphib Water, Summer Only

Nature of Emergency:

• Diabetic attack and exposure. Man was found collapsed behind the Scud Camp Office, He is now located inside the office. Orange smoke is deployed.

Location of Emergency:

- N57 22.2592 W131 24.9736'– Alt 6887' NDB Freq 250 <u>TOPO MAP</u>
- Bearing from CBW4 is 281° for 54 miles

Medical Destination and Way Points:

• Telegraph Creek Hospital Heli: M027B Float: M027B Wheeled/Ski: M027X

Starting Location: Bob Quinn Lake - CBW4

- Helicopter: CBW4 Amphibian: Position at: N56° 58.4508' W130° 15.3731' Heading 16.6°
- Wheeled/Ski: CBW4

Special Instructions:

- **Helicopter:** Start at Bob Quinn Lake CBW4. Set the ADF frequency at 250. Fly a bearing of 280° for 54 miles. The landing zone is ice at altitude of 6900 feet. Watch for orange smoke deployed near office. Pick up Victim and fly to Telegraph Creek M027B
- Amphibian: (Summer Only!) Position at N56° 58.4508' W130° 15.3731' Heading 16.6° (Bob Quinn Lake Dock). Set ADF frequency at 250. Fly a bearing of 280° for 54 miles. The landing zone is ice and at an altitude of 6900 feet. Look for orange smoke deployed at the Scud Camp Office. Pick up the victim and fly to Telegraph Creek M027B.
- Wheeled/Ski: Start at Bob Quinn Lake CBW4. Set ADF frequency at 250. Fly a bearing of 280° for 54 miles. The landing zone is ice at an altitude of 6900 feet. Orange smoke is deployed near the office where the victim is waiting inside. Fly the victim to Telegraph Creek Hospital landing at way point M027X.
