

RTMM MedEvac Dispatch E046B Equipment: Helicopter/ Amphib Mining accident Tulsequah Chief Mine, B.C., CDN

Special RTMM Scenery Requirements:

ORBX SAK

ORBX PAJN Juneau

TKL Taku Lodge

Starting Location: TKL Taku Lodge, Ak, USA

Heli: N58 29.4270 W133 56.4990, 15 ft, 330° (unpublished)

Amphib: GA Dock 01 or 02

Location of Emergency:

Tulsequah Chief Mine, BC, CDN

Bearing from Taku Lodge is 008° for 20 nm, My Topo

Medical Destination:

Bartlett Regional, Juneau, Ak, USA at waypoint M001H, M001F respectively

Nature of Emergency:

A worker was spilled in the mine and transported by a pickup to the helipad of Tulsequah Chief Mine airstrip.

Emergency Waypoint:

Helo evac: Set the GPS to waypoint E046B and plan your flight, touch down on the helipad where the helpers are waiting for you. After having stabilized the patient give a fast transport to Bartlett Regional M001H.

Amphib Evac: Set the GPS to waypoint E046B. Land on the dirt strip of Tulsequah Chief Mine and taxi to the helipad. Pick up the injured and hurry for Bartlett Regional M001F medical dock.
