Nature of Emergency: Possible Heart Attack at Ice Station Research Station

- **Known Data:** Possible Heart Attack, patient alert, but pain down right arm, dizzy, having speech problems. Ready for Transport.

Equipment: Helicopter or Ski Plane (or Tundra)

Starting Location: CAB6 – Scud River

Emergency Location: Bearing from Scud River is 201* for 28.2 NM, Altitude 4700'/1430m

Emergency Way Point: E052B at GPS N56 58.4569 - W132 27.8671

Destination Way Point: M003F

Helicopter Instructions:

- Start at CAB6, Scud River. Fly a bearing of 201 degrees for 28.2 NM. The way point altitude is 4700 feet ... runway is short and is ice. There is an orange smoke flare to guide you to the patient location. Pick up the patient and fly to the Petersburg Medical Center at way point M003.

Float Plane/Amphibian Instructions
